

The Crestwood - Sunset Hills Rotary Club Arts and Crafts Fair was started in 1982 with 100 crafters. This humble beginning was the start of something very special. Our fall show, held at Lindbergh High School, is always the weekend before Thanksgiving. We celebrated the Craft Fair's 25th Anniversary in 2006.

Our show has grown to 490 crafters who exemplify only the best Arts and Crafts in the region. We have been featured in Southern Living Magazine, Midwest Living Magazine and online at Country Home Magazine. We have a wonderful following of customers who shop at our show every year. There is truly something for everyone.

Our Craft Fair Guide contains names of crafters and booth numbers so people can easily locate our crafters. The guide is available to all attending our show, usually around 25,000 people for the fall show. We are also offering advertising in the guide which includes listing your e-mail address, providing opportunities for sales after the show. This information is listed in our application.

In 2006 we started a spring show. Although the show is half the size of the fall event, it is the largest spring show in the area. We estimate that the crowd is around 5,000 to 7,000 people.

We are very proud of our shows. 100% of the proceeds are returned to community projects and programs, as well as Rotary International projects. These include eradicating polio, providing water wells in Zimbabwe, rendering eye surgeries in India, and reducing infant mortality around the world.
